To reduce the risk of fire or electric shock, DO NOT remove any service covers. DO NOT modify the appliance in any way that is not described in these instructions. NO user serviceable parts included. Repair MUST be done by authorized personnel only.

In the event of signs of damage, for example if there is a smell of burning, unplug the machine immediately from outlet and contact JURA customer service.

- ▲ CAUTION This appliance is for household use. Any servicing other than cleaning and user maintenance shall be performed by an authorized service representative:
  - Do not immerse base in water or try to disassemble.
  - Do not put the appliance or any individual parts in the dishwasher.
  - Check voltage to be sure that the voltage indicated on the name plate complies with your voltage. The name plate is located on the underside of the appliance.
  - Never use warm or hot water to fill the water container. Use cold water only.
  - Keep your hands and the cord away from hot parts of the appliance during operation.

There is a risk of scalds or burns on the spouts.

- Keep children away.
- Do not touch any hot parts. Use the handles or knobs provided.

#### NOTICE



NEVER DO (or you will void your warranty protection):

- Never clean with scouring powders or hard implements.
- Ensure that the ventilation slots are not covered.
- Never pull out the drip tray during the brewing process. Only pull the drip tray when the display instructs you or when the appliance is ready for use.

- Never fill instant coffee, chocolate mix etc. into the bean container or ground coffee funnel (filler funnel for ground coffee). It will damage the functioning of the brewing chamber.
- Never fill sugar coated coffee beans into the bean container. In case of doubt, call your dealer.
- Never fill anything other than coffee beans into the bean container (no chocolate, no rice, no nuts, no spices, nothing other than roasted coffee beans).
- Never fill frozen beans into the bean container. If you store beans in the freezer, let them thaw 3 to 4 hours before filling them into the bean container.
- Never fill anything but fresh, cold and clean water into the water tank, except when decalcifying.
- Never use mineral or carbonated water. You can use tap water, bottled water, spring water and reverse osmosis water.
- Never do anything with the machine which is not described in these instructions. In case of doubt, call your dealer.

# 3 Preparing and using for the first time

#### Setting up the machine

When setting up your E4, please note the following:

- Place the E4 on a horizontal surface that is not sensitive to water.
- Choose a spot for your E4 which protects the machine against overheating. Ensure that the ventilation slots are not covered.



Filling the bean container	The bean container has an aroma preservation cover. This will ensure that your coffee beans retain their aroma for longer.
NOTICE	<ul> <li>Coffee beans which have been treated with additives (e.g. sugar), ground coffee or freeze-dried coffee will damage the grinder.</li> <li>Only use roasted, untreated coffee beans to fill the bean container.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Remove the aroma preservation cover.</li> <li>Remove any dirt or foreign objects from inside the bean container.</li> <li>Fill the bean container with coffee beans and close the aroma preservation cover.</li> </ul>
Determining the water hardness	<ul> <li>When you use the machine for the first time, you must set the water hardness. If you do not know the hardness of your water, you can find this out first. Use the Aquadur® test strips supplied with the machine.</li> <li>Hold the test strip under flowing water for one second. Shake off the water.</li> <li>Wait for about 1 minute.</li> <li>You will then be able to read the degree of water hardness from the discoloration of the Aquadur® test strip and the</li> </ul>

#### First-time use

#### 3 Preparing and using for the first time







- ► Turn the filter cartridge clockwise until it audibly clicks into place.
- ► Fill the water tank with fresh, cold water and reinsert the tank.
  - **i** The machine automatically detects that you have just inserted the filter cartridge. The **() () () ()** so symbols flash from right to left to show that you need to open the switch for hot water preparation.
- ► Place a receptacle under the hot-water spout.
- ► Turn the switch to the ☆ position. The filter is rinsed. Water flows out of the hot-water spout. Rinsing of the filter stops automatically. The ?? ?? Symbols flash from left to right.
- ► Turn the switch to the ① position. The '\u00c7 symbol lights up.
- Empty the drip tray and put it back into the machine.
- Place a receptacle under the coffee spout.
   The ???? Symbols flash while the E4 is heating up.
   The machine is rinsed. Water flows out of the coffee spout.
   The rinse stops automatically. Your E4 is ready for use.

#### Connecting the machine to the WiFi network (optionally)



Your E4 can be connected with your JURA app (J.O.E.<sup>°</sup>).

Precondition: J.O.E.\* is installed on your mobile end device. The optionally available JURA WiFi Connect is inserted into the service socket of your E4.

# 4 Preparation

#### A WARNING

Hot coffee, hot steam and hot water can cause scalding. Scalding is a serious burn.

- ► Use extreme care when handling hot liquid or steam.
- Allow liquid to cool down before drinking.
- In the event of scalding, rinse affected area with cold water and seek medical attention.
- Keep children AWAY.

#### Basic information about preparing drinks:

Aim	What to do
Select coffee strength	Press the <b>()</b> button before preparation: 'mild' ( <b>()</b> ), 'normal' ( <b>() ()</b> ) or 'strong' ( <b>() () ()</b> ). The E4 remembers the last option selected for the next preparation.

- **i** All products can also be prepared using the JURA app (J.O.E.<sup>®</sup>).
- **i** With the JURA app (J.O.E.<sup>\*</sup>) you can make two additional specialty coffees: the caffè Barista and the lungo Barista.

Coffee tastes best served hot. A cold porcelain cup cools the beverage – and impairs the taste. We therefore recommend prewarming the cups. You can purchase a JURA cup warmer from your specialized dealer.

#### Espresso and coffee



#### Example: Coffee

- ► Place a cup under the coffee spout.
- ► Press the 🗭 button.

The preset amount of water for coffee flows into the cup.

#### Example: Two espressi

- ► Place a cup under the coffee spout.
- ► Press the button 2x.
  - **i** Two brewing operations take place one after the other. Change the cup before the second brewing operation.
  - i To prepare two coffees, press the ₽ button 2x.

The preset amount of water for espresso flows into the cup.

- ► Place a cup under the hot-water spout.
- Turn the switch to the position.
   Hot water flows into the cup.
- ► Turn the switch to position ① to stop the preparation of hot water.

The JURA app (J.O.E.<sup>\*</sup>) offers two additional products for you to choose from: caffè Barista and lungo Barista.

#### Example: Lungo Barista

- ► Place a cup under the hot-water spout.
- ► In the JURA app (J.O.E.<sup>®</sup>), tap the product 'Lungo Barista'.
- ► Follow the instructions in the app.

It is easy to make permanent settings for the amount of water for all specialty coffees according to the cup size. Adjust the amount once as shown in the following example. Every time you prepare a drink in the future, this amount of water will be dispensed.

**Example:** Proceed as follows to **permanently** set the amount of water for one coffee.



#### Adjusting the grinder

#### CAUTION

- ► Place a cup under the coffee spout.
- ► Press the ♥ button for about 2 seconds. The coffee flows into the cup.
- Press any button as soon as there is sufficient coffee in the cup.
   Preparation stops. The set amount of water for one coffee is permanently stored.
  - **i** You can alter this setting at any time by repeating the above procedure.

You can adjust the grinder to suit the degree of roast of your coffee.

If you adjust the consistency of grind when the grinder is not operating, the grinder adjustment switch could be damaged.

- ► Only adjust the consistency of grind when the grinder is running.
  - **i** The consistency of grind is correct if the coffee flows regularly from the coffee spout. In addition a fine, thick crema forms.

Grinder adjustment switch

- 1: Fine consistency of grind setting
- 2: Coarse consistency of grind setting

**Example:** Proceed as follows to change the consistency of grind **during** the preparation of an espresso.

- ► Place a cup under the coffee spout.
- Open the cover of the filler funnel for ground coffee.
- ► Press the button.
- Turn the grinder adjustment switch to the desired position while the grinder is running.

The preset amount of water flows into the cup.

Close the filler funnel cover.

You can choose to use a second coffee variety, for example decaffeinated coffee, with the filter funnel for ground coffee.

#### Basic information about ground coffee:

- Never add more than two level measuring spoons of ground coffee.
- Use ground coffee which is not ground too finely. Very fine coffee can block up the system so that the coffee only comes out in drips.



#### Ground coffee

- If you did not fill the machine with enough ground coffee, the <sup>3</sup>/<sub>2</sub> symbol flashes and the E4 stops the operation.
- The desired specialty coffee must be prepared within approximately one minute after filling with the ground coffee. Otherwise the E4 stops the operation and is once more ready for use.

All specialty coffees with ground coffee are always prepared following the same model.

**Example:** Proceed as follows to prepare an espresso using ground coffee.

- ► Place an espresso cup under the coffee spout.
- Press the Ø button several times until the \* symbol lights up brightly.
- Open the powder chute cover.
- Place one level measuring spoon of ground coffee into the filler funnel.
- Close the cover of the filler funnel.
- ► Press the button.

The preset amount of water for espresso flows into the cup.

# 5 Daily operation

# Switching the machine on and off



- ► Place a receptacle under the coffee spout.
- ▶ Press the On/Off button 🖒.
  - **i** When the machine is switched off, the system is only rinsed if a specialty coffee has been prepared.

The system rinses itself. Your E4 is switched on or off.

Filling the water tank	Daily maintenance of the machine and hygiene when handling coffee and water are key to a perfect coffee result in the cup every time. You should therefore change the water <b>daily</b> .

# 6 Permanent settings in programming mode

In programming mode you can set the switch-off time and water hardness. Press the **O** button to enter programming mode.

Automatic switch-offBy instructing your E4 to automatically switch itself off, you can cut<br/>down your energy consumption. Your E4 switches off automatically<br/>after the preset time following the last action on the machine.

The number of symbols that are brightly lit up indicates the set switch-off time:

Press the Ö button.

The le symbol lights up brightly.

- ► Press the ♥ button several times until the ♥ symbol lights up brightly.
- ▶ Press the **()** button to enter the program item.
- Press the ♥ / ♥ button to change the setting for the switch-off time.
- Press the Ø button to confirm the setting.
  - i The setting must be confirmed within 20 seconds.

The **() () () (:** symbols flash 3 times in quick succession.

- Press the O button to exit programming mode.
  - **i** The automatic switch-off can also be set using the JURA app (J.O.E.<sup>\*</sup>).

Setting the water hardness The harder the water, the more frequently you need to descale the E4 or change the filter. It is therefore important to set the water hardness accurately.

The water hardness was set when the machine was first used. You can change this setting at any time.

The number of symbols that are brightly lit up indicates the set water hardness level:

Press the O button.

The gymbol lights up brightly.

- ► Press the ♥ button several times until the is symbol lights up brightly.

- Press the ♥/♥ button to change the setting for the water hardness.
- ▶ Press the ♥ button to confirm the setting.

**i** The setting must be confirmed within 20 seconds.

The **() () () S** symbols flash 3 times in quick succession.

► Press the **Ø** button to exit programming mode.

#### Descaling the machine

**Precondition:** The 🔅 symbol lights up. The water tank is filled.

- Empty the drip tray and coffee grounds container and put them back into the machine.
- ► Place a receptacle under the coffee spout.
- Press the Ø button.
   The Ø Ø symbols light up, water flows out of the coffee spout.
   The operation is interrupted, the <sup>&</sup> symbol lights up.
- Open the cover of the filler funnel for ground coffee.
- ► Insert a JURA cleaning tablet into the filler funnel.
- ► Close the cover of the filler funnel.
- Press the Ø button.
   The Ø Ø Ø symbols light up, water flows out of the coffee spout several times.
   The operation stops automatically.
   The 😴 symbol lights up.
- ► Empty the drip tray and coffee grounds container and put them back into the machine. The ? ? ? ? Symbols flash 3 times in guick succession.

The E4 builds up deposits of limescale over time and automatically prompts you to descale it when necessary. The degree of calcification depends on the hardness of your water.

If you are using a CLEARYL Smart filter cartridge, you will not be prompted to descale. However, should you need to descale the E4, first switch the machine to descaling mode (see section 7 "Maintenance – Switching the machine from filter mode to descaling mode").

Non-recommended descaling agents (e.g. vinegar) may contain substances that could damage the machine or leave residues.

 Use only original JURA descaling tablets. These are formulated especially for your machine. ▲ WARNING Harmful and irritating descaling agent. Harmful if swallowed. Irritating to eyes and skin.

- ► Keep children AWAY.
- Avoid contact with skin and eyes.
- ► Avoid generation of dust. Do not inhale dust.
- ► After contact with skin, wash immediately with plenty of water. In case of skin irritation, seek medical advice.
- ► After eye contact, immediately flush eyes with plenty of water. Remove contact lenses. Seek medical advice.
- If swallowed, rinse mouth immediately and drink large quantities of water. Do not induce vomiting. Seek medical advice immediately and show label.
- **NOTICE** If the descaling operation is interrupted, there may be damage to the machine.
  - ► Allow the descaling program to run to the end.
    - **i** The descaling program lasts approximately 45 minutes.
    - **i** JURA descaling tablets are available from specialized dealers.
    - **1** If the descaling agent comes into contact with sensitive surfaces (e.g. marble), damage cannot be ruled out. Clean up any splashes immediately.

**Precondition:** The gymbol lights up.

- Press the button for about 2 seconds.
   The symbol lights up.
- Empty the drip tray and coffee grounds container and put them back into the machine.
   The : symbol flashes.
- ► Place a receptacle under the hot-water spout.
- ► Remove and empty the water tank.



#### 7 Maintenance



- Completely dissolve 3 JURA descaling tablets in a receptacle holding 17 oz (500 ml) of water. This may take several minutes.
- Pour the solution into the empty water tank and insert it into the machine.

The () () () () symbols flash from right to left to show that you need to open the switch for hot water preparation.

- ► Turn the switch to the position. Water flows repeatedly out of the hot-water spout. The process stops automatically. The ?? ?? Symbols flash from left to right.
- ► Turn the switch to position ①. The descaling operation is continued. The '=' symbol lights up.
- Empty the drip tray and coffee grounds container and put them back into the machine.

The 🚦 symbol lights up.

- ► Remove the water tank and rinse it thoroughly.
- Fill the water tank with fresh, cold water and reinsert the tank. The ♥ ♥ ♥ ★ symbols flash from right to left.
- ► Place a receptacle under the hot-water spout.

- Turn the switch to position ①.
   The descaling operation is continued.

- Empty the drip tray and coffee grounds container and put them back into the machine.

i If the descaling operation stops unexpectedly, rinse the water tank thoroughly.

**Cleaning the bean container** Coffee beans may be covered with a slight oil film which remains on the walls of the bean container. These traces may negatively affect the coffee result. For this reason clean the bean container from time to time.

- ▶ Press the On/Off button ♂ to switch the E4 off.
- ► Remove the aroma preservation cover.
- Clean the bean container with a soft, dry cloth.
- Fill the bean container with coffee beans and close the aroma preservation cover.

#### Descaling the water tank

Limescale deposits may form in the water tank. To ensure correct function of the machine, descale the water tank from time to time.

- ► Remove the water tank.
- ► If you use a CLEARYL Smart filter cartridge, remove this.
- Completely fill the water tank and dissolve 3 JURA descaling tablets in it.
- Leave the water tank with the descaling solution for several hours (e.g. overnight).
- Empty the water tank and rinse it thoroughly.
- ► If you use a CLEARYL Smart filter cartridge, insert this again.
- ► Fill the water tank with fresh, cold water and reinsert the tank.

Follow the steps below to switch the E4 from filter mode to descaling mode.

- Remove the water tank.
- Turn the filter cartridge anticlockwise and remove it along with the extension from the water tank.
- ► Fill the water tank and reinsert it.
- Press the O button.
   The symbol lights up brightly.
- Press the ♥ ('Large cup') button several times until the ① symbol lights up brightly.
- ► Press the Ø button to enter the program item. The Ø Ø Ø model: The B model and a model of the program item.
- Press the 
  ('Small cup') button so that the () () 
  Straight op brightly.
- Press the Ø button to confirm the setting.

i The setting must be confirmed within 20 seconds.

The **() () () ()** symbols flash 3 times in quick succession. The machine is now in descaling mode.

Press the O button to exit programming mode.
